## SSO Vacancies

We are sad to announce that at the end of this half term, Mr Friswell will be leaving Hearsall to join the Royal Marines. This means that we have two vacancies for site services officers (Mr Friswell currently does both roles)

**Post 1: 37 hr post all year round £17,772 to £22,268.** a full time Site Services Officer. The post is all year round and 37 hrs per week on a split shift. There is no accommodation on site for this post.

**Post 2: 10 hr post term time only £4,152 to £5,016.** A ten hour Site Services Officer, term time only post, working in the evening times to accommodate school lettings. There is also no accommodation on site for this post.
