- ❖ All day Nursery care; parents will be able to choose from a morning or afternoon place; 30 hour provision and a flexible choice of sessions i.e. 2½ full days or 5 mornings etc. This provision will be led by a qualified Early Years Teacher and Practitioners.
- ❖ In addition, Hearsall Community Academy will take over the running of the Before/After School Provision (the name of which will be chosen by the children over the coming months). We would like to reassure working parents that children from Nursery to Year 6 will be able to access care from 7.45 am until 6.00 pm.
- ❖ A registration letter for Nursery parents for September 2018 will be sent out to all parents on request and to those of you who have already contacted the school office.
- ❖ Registration for Before and After School Club will take place during the summer term.
