Skern Residential!

The children enjoyed a wonderful residential in North Devon earlier this year. Through a range of activities, which included canoeing, rock climbing and surfing, the children pushed themselves and took many perceived risks during their stay. It was also a wonderful opportunity for Year 6 to be together and to develop a range of social and team work skills.



Theme- The Blitz!

The children learned all about the outbreak of War within Coventry and the United Kingdom as a whole, as well as learning about why WW11 broke out. Through reading and investigating 'Rationing Books,' the children explored how everyday life was affected by the War. The theme allowed the children to focus on many Art and Design skills. For example the children created different structures for 'Air Raid' shelters, as well as using appropriate artistic techniques to sketch the Coventry Blitz. Wartime Music was also explored, as the children discussed the sounds and instruments that were used to represent the images of the Blitz.

A particular highlight from 'The Blitz!' theme was the trip to Coventry Cathedral to explore the effects of the infamous Coventry Blitz. During this visit, the children participated in specialised workshops to explore the night from a variety of different people and perspectives, all of whom 'lived through' that fateful night. The children performed a very special Christmas based Assembly to their families in Mid- December. Through a range of drama activities, including historical dance and song, the children once again showed us that they are a very talented bunch!
