## This Week at Hearsall

Welcome to the first Newsletter of this school year. The children have settled quickly into their new vibrant classrooms with old and new staff. We have been excited to get started on our learning and the first full week has been focused on settling children, building friendships and developing relationships.

**Building update:** Works are close to completion on the roof and basement. The heating is being installed in phases with the lower end of the building past Melbourne Hall being the current phase. Works are complete on the main corridor and classrooms on the first floor and Year 1 are housed temporarily on the third floor while their classrooms are having new heating installed.

**Class Dojo** should be up and running for all classes now but please contact your child's class teacher should you experience any difficulties.

**Entrances and exits to school:** As a result of the building works children are entering and leaving the school using both playgrounds. Reception and Years 1, 2 and 3 are using the Bristol Road playground while Years 4, 5 and 6 are using the Kingston Road playground. We have returned to free flow so children can enter between 8.45 and 8.55am. Please be reassured that if you have a message to pass on to the class teacher in the morning there will be a teaching assistant from that phase available on the door to take a message. Alternatively, please contact the main office. To support you in identifying staff members I will send out a photo page of all staff with names and phases so you know who to speak to.
