In maths this week the children have been learning about Volume and have continued their addition and subtraction problem solving using the bar model. This week in Science Year 3 have been learning about how water is transported around plants. We put celery into food dye and left the sticks for a few days before we investigated what had happened. When we cut the celery sticks we could see where the food dye had travelled up the stalk! We talked about the different tubes within plants that allow the water to travel all around plants.

Year 4 have had a fun week. We have been exploring the poetry of Michael Rosen. We have been reading lots of his work from the book 'Jelly Boots, Smelly Boots' and watching him pull many silly faces in his You Tube videos. We have also been exploring the oral traditions of the native Americans, looking at the stories they tell and we had a go at re-writing one of our own. We look forward to a busy last week of term!
