- ❖ Make a visual timetable for a day in the life of your family. Include the start and end times of each activity. Calculate the amount of time spent doing each activity over the day.

## Creative

- ❖ Look through family photographs and make a family tree. You can draw it, make a model or use photos to create it on the computer.
- ❖ Draw a portrait (of yourself, your family, a family member or your pet!) in the style of Picasso.

- ❖ Choreograph a dance to your favourite song. Teach it to your family! You could have a family talent show!



## Investigative
