Weekly Learning Tasks for week beginning 6.4.20

These tasks cover various skills **English, Maths, Creative** and **Investigative.**

We recommend completing 8 or more of these tasks this week. The activities that are **bold and underlined** may require more adult support. Enjoy! 😊

Maths

- ❖ Choose one of the celebration pictures and write 10 word problems using the pictures using addition and subtraction. 
- ❖ You have £150 to plan a party for your favourite celebration. You will have 20 guests coming. Create a list of all the things you would buy and keep a running total of your costs. All of your guests must be able to have the same amount of whatever you buy whether this is: food, gifts, cutlery, napkins etc. You can have additional things such as: DJ, resources for games, table clothes etc.
- ❖ Find out the dates of different celebrations this year. Use the numbers and make at least 20 calculations to complete. E.g. Valentine's Day -14 2 20 (14×2 , $20 - 14$, $20 + 14$ etc).

Creative

- ❖ Think about your favourite celebration and create someone special a card, ready to give it to them during the celebration.
- ❖ Create your own pass the parcel and play with members of your household. Play other traditional party games too! You could play musical statues, musical chairs, sleeping lions and other favourites.
- ❖ Make a poster for a celebration event e.g. a special birthday party, Diwali celebration.
- ❖ Design and make some decorations for a wedding celebration.



Investigative

- ❖ Investigate the best way to make pancakes from scratch. After, with a member of your household, make the pancakes and serve them for dessert after your evening meal.
- ❖ Find out the dates of special celebrations in 2020. Put them into a timeline in chronological order. Annotate with facts and extra information.
- Learn some magic tricks to perform at a party. Try them out on family members. You could film you doing them to show your teacher!
