Maths

- ❖ Test your number and problem solving skills with 'The Mystery of the Eggleton Easter Egg Hunt.' You will need to crack codes and find words to find out who the egg smasher is? **Good luck!** 
- ❖ Egg symmetry - Look at the pictures of the eggs. Can you complete the other half of the picture so the eggs are symmetrical? 
- ❖ Easter Sunday is on 12 April. What do you know about the number 12? List at least 20 different number facts with the answer of 12. Y2 - Challenge yourself to use all four operations e.g. $24 \div 2 = 12$.

Creative

- ❖ Can you design, paint and decorate a hard-boiled egg as your favourite cartoon character or superhero? You will need the help of an adult for this one. Please send us photos of your completed design.

- ❖ Make your very own Easter card. Easter cards are often presented with eggs or pictures of Spring such as daffodils, rabbits and new born chicks. Again, we would love to see photos when you have finished.
