Maths

- ❖ Easter Sunday is on 12 April. What do you know about the number 12? List at least 20 different number facts with the answer of 12. Challenge yourself e.g. $1200 \div 100 = 12$.
- ❖ Name different countries that celebrate Easter around the world. What is the population of each country? Can you order them from the smallest to the largest?
- ❖ Research how tall the world's largest edible Easter egg is. In which country was this made? How tall is it in metres? Can you convert that to cm? Who previously held the Guinness world record for the biggest egg? Compare the heights of both eggs. What is the difference?
- ❖ **Unfold the boxes of Easter eggs and/or other food packaging in your house. Explore the nets of the 3D shapes. Can you make and decorate your own 3D Easter egg box using a net?**

Creative

- ❖ **Research the tradition of Cascarones-** a popular Easter tradition. Where did this tradition originate? Why do people throw Cascarones? Use these instructions to make your own. Be sure to take some photos! <https://www.instructables.com/id/How-To-Make-Cascarones/>
