



## Reading in Key Stage 1

As you already know, reading is extremely important to aid your child's progress with all their learning. Please try to listen to them read as often as possible - at least three times a week.

Whenever you read with your child please write in their diary telling us which page number they have reached. If you feel that your child is reading with confidence and understanding, and think that they are ready to move onto a new book, please write clearly "Please change book". Your child will receive a stamp or sticker every time their book is changed for a new one.

**Reading Rewards!** Children also have a chance to earn 'Reading Rewards' for consistent reading at home and in school. Children receive dojo points for the amount of times they have read at home as long as it is recorded in their diaries.

Books must remain in school on a Monday-Thursday. Finished reading books will be changed when books are in school. Books will be returned home on a Thursday evening for reading over the weekend. Your child will also be heard read by their Class Teachers and Teaching Assistants during school time. Please do not hesitate to ask if you have any questions.
