The children have, as ever, amazed us with their resilience and ability to bounce back after such a long absence. The children have very quickly settled back into old routines and have enjoyed the opportunity to have activities which support settling back in and emotional wellbeing. We have listened carefully to the children and their experiences including completing a questionnaire which overwhelmingly showed they were excited to see their friends and see their teachers.

Lateral Flow testing is really important as it minimises the risk of any infection spreading and catches asymptomatic cases where people may be unaware they have Covid.

You will have seen that we have closed a bubble in school due to our first positive Covid case since the start of the pandemic. This is testament to the staff and children listening, sticking to the guidance and being so careful to prevent cross infection. The closure was very smooth and although it is frustrating sending children home they revert straight to our remote learning.

### Order home test kits online

If you cannot get tested at your workplace or are unable to go to a test site or collect test kits, you can order a home test kit online. Do not order online if you can get a test through other methods. This frees up home delivery for those who need it most. [Order rapid lateral flow home test kits](#)

### Collect test kits

You can collect 2 packs of home test kits at a local collection point. Each pack contains 7 tests. Anyone 18 or over can collect. Most collection points are open from 1.30pm to 7pm. You can check online if the location is open or busy before you go. You do not need to make an appointment. Do not visit a collection point outside opening hours, as it may be used to test people with coronavirus symptoms outside these times. [Find your nearest home test kit collection point.](#)
