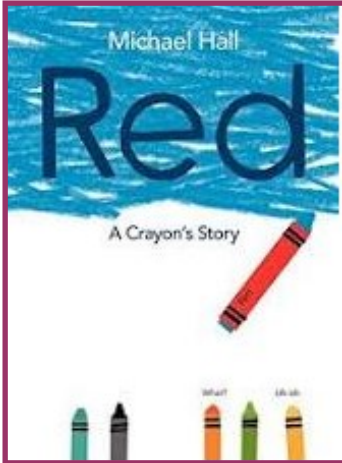


Year 4—Book List

Red: A Crayon's Story - Michael Hall



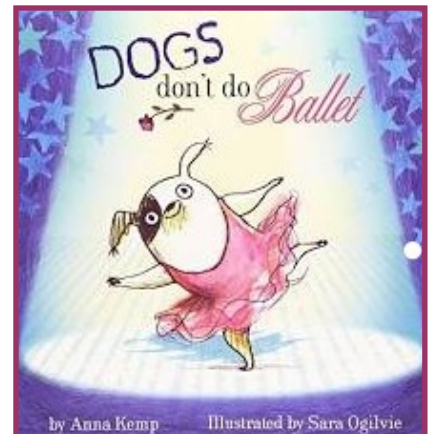
Theme: To be who you want to be

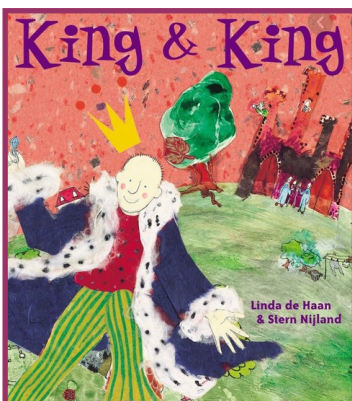
Dog's Don't Do Ballet - Anna Kemp and Sara Ogilvie
