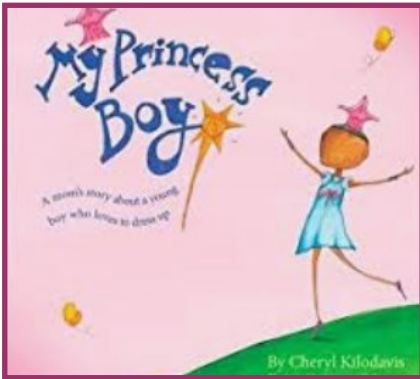


Year 6 — Book List

My Princess Boy—Cheryl Kilodavis



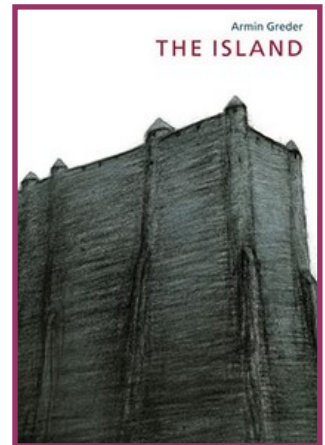
Theme: To promote diversity

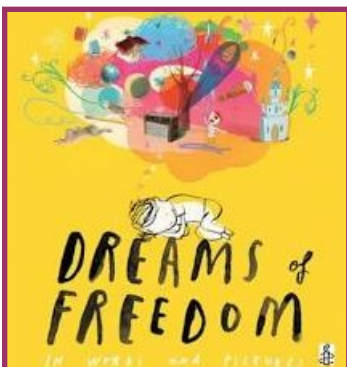
The Island—Armin Greder
