

Writing in Year 1

- Say out loud a sentence before they write it
- Create a sequence of sentences (story, information text)
- Read through their writing to check it makes sense
- To read aloud their writing to others



Grammar and Punctuation

- To use capital letter, full stop, finger spaces
- To understand and begin to use question marks and exclamation marks
- To use capital letters for people, places and days of the week
- To begin to identify nouns, adjectives and verbs in sentences
- To begin to use past and present tense correctly





<u>Spelling</u>

- To spell most of the HFW and Y1 common exception words
- To spell words using their Phonic knowledge
- To spell words ending in -s or
 es correctly
- To spell days of the week


