Reading in Year 3



Key objectives for Year 3: Word Reading

- Applying knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes.
- Comprehension
 - -Talk about a wide range of books, fiction, poetry, plays and non-fiction.
 - Predict what might happen from details stated and implied.
 - Use dictionaries to check the meaning of words they have read.
 - Ask relevant questions to improve their understanding of the text.
 - Draw inferences such as character's feelings, thoughts and motives).
- Skilled word reading

 Speedy decoding of pronunciation

- Speedy recognition of familiar words









Key objectives for Year 3:

- -Demonstrate some variety of sentence structures using a range of adverbial and prepositional phrases.
- -Use some direct speech within narrative writing.
- -Use headings and sub-headings to aid presentation.
- -Proof-read for common spelling and punctuation errors.
- -Read aloud their own writing to a group or the whole class, using appropriate intonation.





Key objectives for Year 3:

- Pupils will be taught the grammatical terminology and concepts
- Using and punctuating speech
- Indicating possession
- Correctly punctuating fronted adverbials





- Children should be able to spell common words correctly, including common exception words.
- Use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters and understand letters are best left unjoined
- Increase the legibility, consistency and quality of their handwriting
