Shining the spotlight on D&T!

This week Years 5 & 6 have kick-started their Summer Term Design & Technology unit. The children have researched cakes by taste testing a range in order to consider the appearance and flavours within them. They have then worked in groups to start to design their cakes ahead of making them over the next few weeks. The skills the children will be learning will set them up for their futures with handling and preparing food safely.







Year 5 Science

Year 5 had completed a practical and engaging science session this week looking at forces. In groups, we built parachutes using different materials and carried out a fair test to see which material would create the slowest falling parachute. Our results showed us that, the parachutes made with thinner materials worked best. We also predicted that if we had made the parachutes bigger they would have more air resistance and the parachutes would've been more successful. We are very much looking forward to next science lesson where we will be building boats and investigating water resistance.
